

Are you the project Manager that StromaBio needs?

Swedish StromaBio AB is a young Swedish biopharma company developing ATMP based on mesenchymal stromal cells to treat life threatening inflammatory conditions. We are now recruiting a project manager with a scientific background in immunology that will drive our priority project into clinical phase. Key features are a solution-oriented mindset, a scientific curiosity, and a general interest in becoming a key player in our team. The project manager will be responsible for the direction, coordination, implementation, and control of projects, while remaining aligned with strategy, commitments, and goals of the company.

We are looking for a person with expertise in immunology as we wish to strengthen our competence in understanding the multifaceted mechanism of action and designing potency assays. In addition, the StromaBio sister company CuraCell AB is developing a Tumor infiltrating lymphocyte cell therapy that additional scientific expertise in immunology. The project manager/scientist will initially split the work between StromaBio and CuraCell.

The role

As a project manager you will handle all work streams for your project/s. You will do the initial work for new tasks, set the framework together with management and identify needed work streams and competences to be able to perform the project in time. In your role you will manage team members both within and outside the organization. The work will include the travelling. With your experience in immunology and cell biology you will also function as a specialist in product development and validation of manufacturing methods.

Main responsibilities

- Project management using Microsoft 365, including budget and time management.
- Preclinical development that will include independently assessing scientific literature, write study plans, perform, or supervise others, and report. This will require troubleshooting skills.
- Interpreting study project specifications from external partners, also handle agreements and other documents between StromaBio and external organizations.
- Manage and to some/large extent write application for funding of project. Identify relevant calls and potential partners.
- Identify and coordinate the resources needed to compile the full clinical trial dossier and apply for clinical trial.
- Communicating with sales and technical experts regarding potential purchases of equipment, raw materials etc.
- Reach out to management when you see potential risks in the project, push for meetings or needed help necessary for the project.

Requirements:

• Minimum a bachelor's degree in biomedical sciences, cell biology, biochemistry, or similar relevant area.



- PhD in immunology, stem cell biology, or similar relevant topic. Hands-on experience
 in flow cytometry, methods in isolation and activation of immune cells is mandatory
 competences.
- >3 years work experience in relevant area after PhD defense. It will be meriting if you have managed projects in biotech industry or managed projects with strict deadlines in a similar setting.
- Sound understanding of research methodologies in general. Be able to assess method documents from literature, patents documents etc.
- Proficiency in Microsoft365
- Experienced in working with ELN (or similar electronic lab book system).
- Fluent in English both orally and in writing and preferably Swedish. German is meriting.

To thrive in this role, you should be resourceful and demonstrate excellent organizational and time management skills. You are good at identifying potential problems and risks but use the main part of the time for finding solutions. You also understand that the position will involve research and development, mainly within immunology and immune-based assays and you enjoy working in the lab from time to time or supervise lab staff. Another key is communication as you effectively need to be able to communicate with both internal and external partners at all levels. You also enjoy working in a small organization where the work place culture is still being established.

StromaBio offers a high pace, stimulating multidisciplinary working environment. We aim at becoming one of Sweden's strongest ATMP-developing companies where the clinical projects are run in parallell with product development.
